Active Suffolk – Getting the school moving – message from Shan Bendall, Project Officer:

I am writing to you today to let you know about the surveying taking place at **New Cangle Primary School** for the Active Schools Project. The project will work specifically with the school, to provide **free support** to further develop the physical education and sport offer, ensuring that pupils have the best possible physical and mental wellbeing to maximise their potential to achieve within school and go on to live healthy and active lives.

As a starting point, if you have a child in **Year 3-6**, they will be asked to complete a very simple online questionnaire designed especially for children of their age. They will have an individual questionnaire but will be completing it in a time and place where other children from their class will also be taking part. They will do this during the school day at a suitable time decided by their teacher.

If you have a child in **Year 1 or 2**, Active Suffolk would like to ask you to complete on your child's behalf about what types of activities they take part in, including cycling, walking, dance and sport. You can do this by using this questionnaire link:

Lastly, we would like to ask **ALL** parents of the school to complete a Parent survey, if possible. The survey consists of 5 questions and is based on your views, as a parent, on how physically active your child is and how you support them to do so. Please see the link below to access the survey;

You can complete the surveys at home and may find it helpful to complete the survey with your child present. This survey will take around 10-15 minutes to complete and will help support the school with their physical education and sport offer.

The survey does not ask for any personal information and all responses are anonymous. If <u>you</u> do not want your child to complete a survey please let Ms Brading or your child's class teacher know. If you are happy for your child to take part, you do not need to do anything.

Active Suffolk will store your child's information securely and keep it confidential. The school will receive a School Report Card summarising the results from the survey.
