Muddy field and woods

It's great to see many of the children have brought in wellies/outdoors shoes so that they can go on the field or in the woods at break/lunch time. Today, I was out on duty in the woods and myself and the children found some wonderful



mushrooms growing on wooden logs and a newt, in a crisp packet! If your child has not brought in wellies/outdoor shoes yet, please bring them in as they will need them until March/April to go on the field or in the woods.

We know that many parents get frustrated by how muddy their children are when they go home. The main problem is football and lots of enthusiastic tackling. When it is very muddy we do stop the children from playing football to prevent this problem but ideally we'd like them to be having as much fun and exercise as possible. Therefore, from our perspective, we'd rather have children in school with muddy clothes who have had a good lunchtime, than clean clothes all the time. Please don't worry about having them come into school with freshly laundered clothes.

PE Kit

In the winter the children often have lessons outside, as well as in the hall. Please can you make sure that they have in their PE kits: a hoodie, tracksuit bottoms, socks and trainers (that can get muddy). They should also have white t-shirts, shorts and plimsoles for indoor lessons. The children won't be able to use their outdoor shoes (if they have trainers, not wellies) that are in school on the racks outside for PE and would need a separate pair.

Class Dojo comments and messages

We think Class Dojo is an excellent tool for communication. However, we have an issue that has cropped up a few times: when there is a post from the school and parents comment underneath, teachers do not get notifications about this. Therefore, where parents ask questions in the comments, they may get missed by the school staff. Direct messages, however, come up as notifications, therefore, if you have any questions, it is always best to send these as direct messages, not as comments under posts. Our policy for replying to messages is that staff check Class Dojo once a day and will try to reply that day if possible. However, if a message is sent later on, they may not see it until the next day, so for any urgent messages, please contact the school office. For wellbeing reasons, staff do not check messages in the evening or at weekends.

48 hour sickness

We have had a few tummy bugs going around over the past few weeks. Children should be kept off school for 48 hours after their last occasion of vomiting or diarrhoea.
